Paper

Yes

Mixed paper

- Mail, office & school papers
- Magazines & catalogs
- Newspapers & inserts

Boxes

- Cardboard
- Cereal, cracker & pasta boxes
- Shoe, gift & electronic boxes
- Toiletry boxes
- Tissue boxes

No

- Pizza boxes or boxes soiled with food
- Egg cartons
- Refrigerator & freezer boxes
- Paper towels, napkins, paper plates & cups
- Gift wrap & tissue paper
- Paper towel & toilet paper cores

Glass

Yes

- Beverage & food bottles & jars

No

- Drinking glasses, mugs, dishes, cook ware, pottery & vases
- Window & mirror glass
- Containers that held hazardous products, such as nail polish or hobby paints
- Light bulbs

Metal

Yes

- Beverage cans
- Food cans
- Aluminum foil, trays & pie tins

No

- Paint cans
- Aerosol cans
- Containers that held hazardous products, such as paint thinner or automotive fluids
- Scrap metal, such as cookware, nails & hangers

Cartons

Yes

- Milk cartons
- Juice cartons
- Juice boxes (straws removed)
- Soup, broth & wine cartons

No

- Ice cream cartons
- Egg cartons
- Plastic straws
- Foil drink pouches

Plastic

Yes

Bottles & jugs

- Water, soda & juice bottles
- Milk & juice jugs
- Ketchup & salad dressing bottles
- Dish soap bottles & detergent jugs
- Shampoo, soap & lotion bottles

Cups, tubs & containers

- Yogurt, pudding & fruit cups
- Clear plastic cups
- Margarine, cottage cheese, cream cheese, other tubs & lids

No

- Plastic bags
- Styrofoam®
- Containers from hazardous materials such as automotive fluids & pesticides
- Black food trays
- Plastic utensils
- Plastic straws

Overall Preparation of Recyclables

- Do not place recyclables in plastic bags, place them loose in your recycling cart.
- Do not include "tangles" in your cart such as hoses, cords, chains, wires, shredded paper or string lights.

Make sure:

- Containers that held food and beverages are empty, rinsed, free of food debris and not crushed.
- Paper and boxes are dry, flattened and free of grease, food, excess tape, plastic and packaging materials.

Printed on 100% recycled paper.

Some household products are hazardous and should not be placed in the garbage. Take unneeded paint, cleaners, automotive fluids, sharps, batteries, fluorescent bulbs and garden products to:

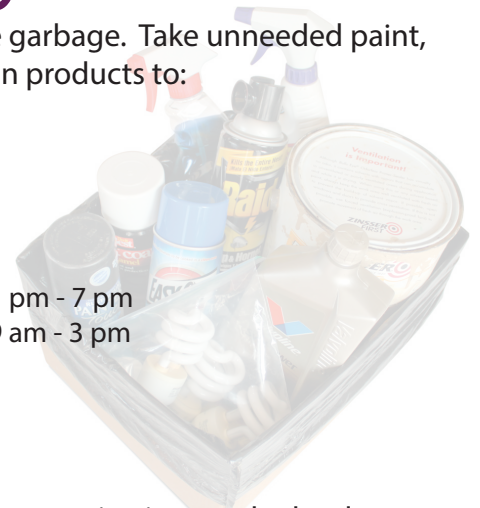

Compost Sites

Anoka County has two compost sites accepting yard waste and organics year-round, weather permitting. Please see hours of operation below. **You must unload your own yard waste and debag all materials.** Please keep leaves/grass, tree waste and organics separate from each other because they are deposited in different areas. For additional details go to AnokaCounty.us/Yardwaste.

Leaves, Grass and Non-woody Yard Waste: Accept debagged grass clippings, leaves, garden waste, weeds, soft-bodied green plant materials, straw, acorns, pine cones and needles. No charge up to four cubic yards.

Tree Waste: Accept brush, evergreen boughs, logs and stumps. Tree waste may be loose or bundled. Fees vary based on the amount and the diameter of the materials.

Organics: Accept all food scraps, most food-soiled, non-recyclable and uncoated paper, and BPI (Biodegradable Products Institute) certified compostable products. FREE to county residents. For additional details go to AnokaCounty.us/Organics.
