



# Craig Park Improvements Project

Construction Update

August 9, 2021

## Project Background:

The City appreciates the neighborhood's continued interest in this project. Through a series of meetings and surveys, resident feedback was used to finalize the Craig Park Improvements which are highlighted on the reverse side of this notice. In addition to addressing historical drainage issues, other key features include treatment of stormwater runoff, improved park amenities, increased park resiliency, and enhanced pollinator habitat.

## Current Events & Schedule:

The City of Fridley awarded the Craig Park Improvements Project to Peterson Companies of Chisago City, MN. **Construction is scheduled to begin August 20<sup>th</sup>, with completion anticipated in late-September.** A detailed schedule is on the project website at the link provided below.

Once construction begins the park will be closed in the active work areas. We will keep access to the playground area until the contractor begins phasing work in the immediate vicinity. The City and Contractor will collaborate in minimizing the inconvenience to residents during construction. Please keep in mind that this type of construction may generate noise, dust and organic odors during grading activities. Generally, it can be a disruption to the neighborhood, but we are working together toward a common goal.
