JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT





#### **BACKGROUND**

- Project includes improvements on 53<sup>rd</sup> Avenue from Main Street to Central Avenue.
- Staff of both cities hosted an event in October of 2019 to receive feedback and input from the residents.
- Project is part of the City's Active Transportation Plan.
- In 2021, the project was successful in obtaining an award of \$1,250,000 through an application submitted for the MnDOT's Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP).



#### PROJECT DESIGN

#### JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT

- Fridley and Columbia Heights share a common boundary from University Avenue to Central Avenue.
- Fridley will be the lead agency on the project.
- The cities will divide costs proportionally to their respective share of the corridor.
- Columbia Heights will lead the property acquisition and utility needs for the project.
- Columbia Heights will reimburse match for the actual costs of engineering, construction and administration, less costs for right-ofway.



#### FINANCIAL IMPACT

- Construction costs are currently estimated at \$1,635,000
- LRIP grant to provide \$1,250,000
- This project is included in the draft 2023-2027 CIP
- Current construction costs are accommodated in the budget
- These costs don't include lighting upgrades
- City's match to be funded using MSA/Local funds
