Water Utility Fund

- Assumptions and Other Considerations
 - Rate increase of 3% for 2024
 - Repayment of the Community Investment Fund Interfund Loan through 2029
 - Increased investment income
 - Use of \$410,000 in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds in 2024
- Proposed Capital Projects
 - \$12,322,000 in capital projects from 2024-2028
 - No use of ARPA funds to fund these capital expenditures from 2025-2028
- Provisional Capital Projects
 - \$1,245,500 Locke Park Water Treatment Plant (WTP) Granular Activated Carbon (GAC) Addition in 2025/26

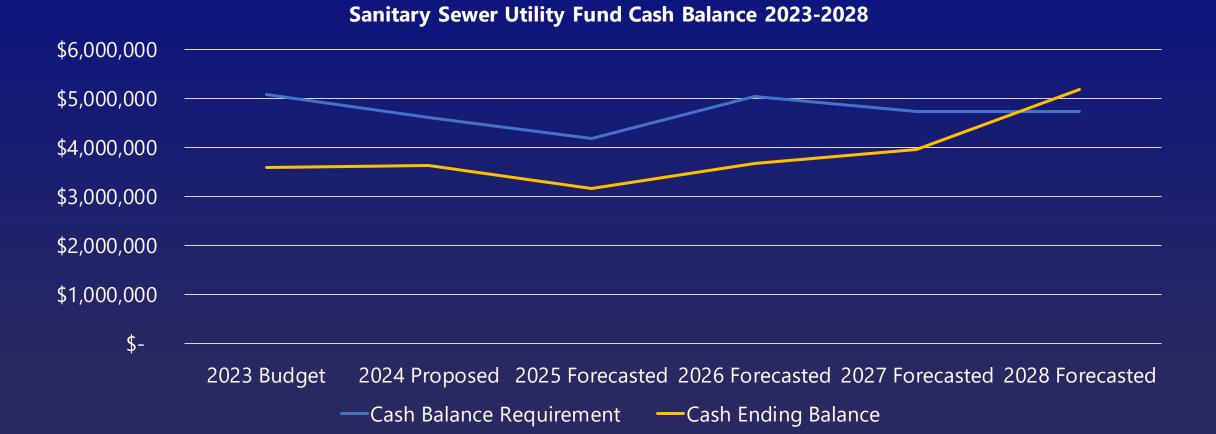


Sanitary Sewer Utility Fund

- Assumptions and Other Considerations
 - Rate increase of 4.5% for 2024
 - Increased investment income
 - Use of \$1,100,000 in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds in 2024
 - Repayment of the Community Investment Fund Interfund Loan through 2026
 - Metropolitan Council Environmental Services (MCES) charges comprise nearly 80% of the total fund operating expenditures
 - 4.45% increase for 2024 or approximately \$232,000
- Proposed Capital Projects
 - \$6,106,000 in capital projects from 2024-2028
 - No use of ARPA funds to fund these capital expenditures from 2025-2028

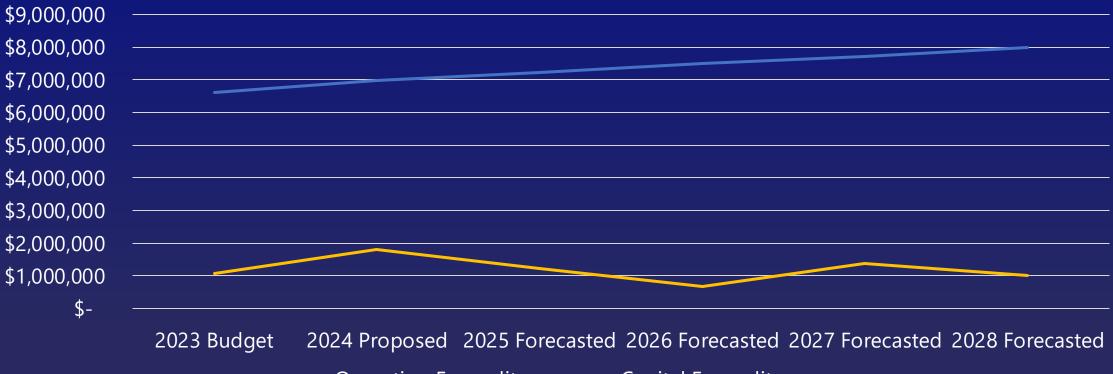


Sanitary Sewer Utility Fund Cash Balance

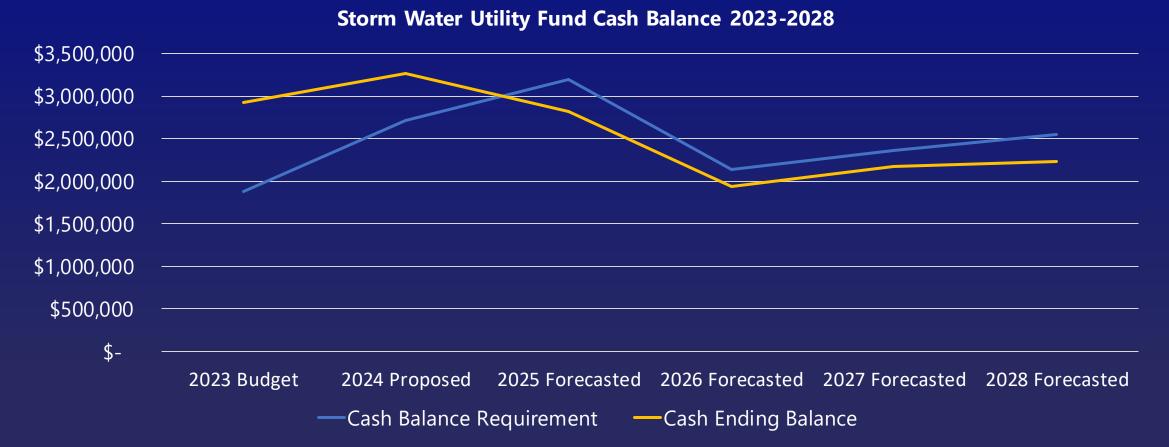


Storm Water Utility Fund

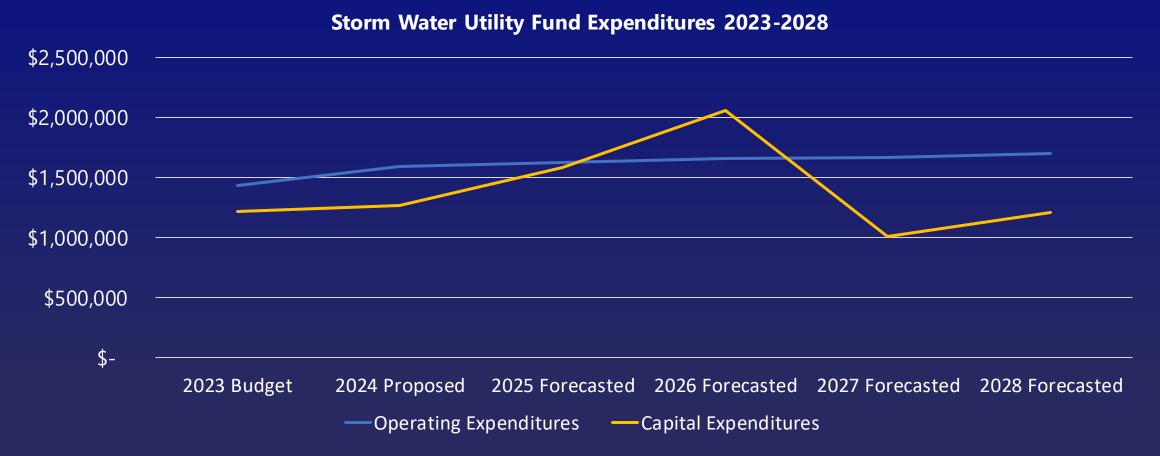
- Assumptions and Other Considerations
 - Rate increase of 10.0% for 2024
 - Increased investment income
 - Repayment of the Community Investment Fund Interfund Loan through 2026
- Proposed Capital Projects
 - \$7,132,500 in capital projects from 2024-2028
 - No use of ARPA funds to fund these capital expenditures from 2024-2028

Solid Waste Abatement (Recycling) Special Revenue Fund

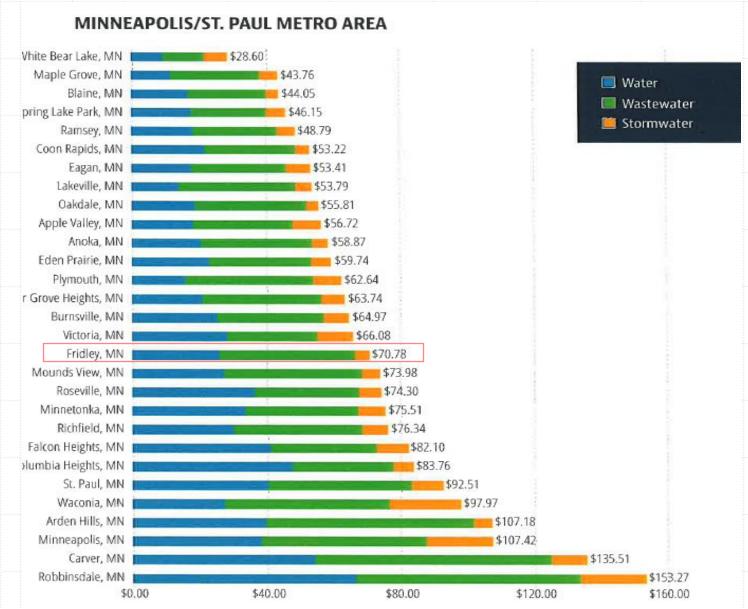
- Proposed 2024 Rate
 - Quarterly rate increase from \$8.50 to \$10.90 or \$2.40 increase (\$0.80 monthly)
- Assumptions and Other Considerations
 - Recycling commodity values have fallen significantly by about \$30/ton
 - New contract with Republic Services goes into effect on May 1

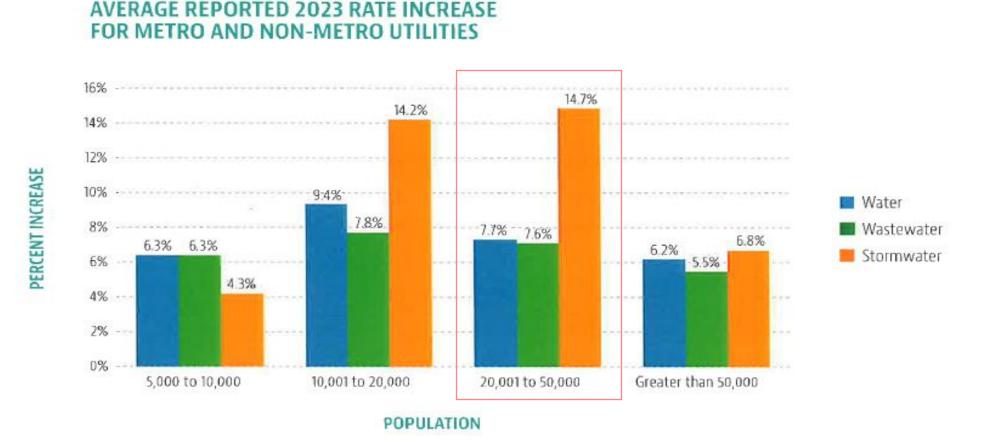
