


Background

- The City of Fridley's Comprehensive Plan and Active Transportation Plans have identified 53rd Avenue as a priority corridor for multimodal improvements that serve bicyclists and pedestrians and to provide safe transportation opportunities for all residents in Fridley.
- The proposed project area includes 53rd Avenue from Main Street to Central Avenue (Trunk Highway 65).
- The City of Fridley leading joint project with City of Columbia Heights.
- Cities of Fridley and Columbia Heights were awarded \$1,250,000 through MnDOT's Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP).




Location Plan

53rd Avenue Trail and Walk Improvements work ELEMENTS

- Street Rehabilitation
 - $_{\circ}$ Reclaim existing pavement \rightarrow New asphalt road
- Trail and Walk Improvements
 - Curb bump out → New bituminous trail on south side of 53rd Avenue (from Main street to Central Avenue)
 - New concrete walkway on north side of 53rd Avenue (from University Avenue to Monroe Street)
- Utility Work (Catch basins relocated and watermain replacement)
- Restoration



Project Partnership

- City of Columbia Heights
 - South side of 53rd Avenue
- MnDOT
 - Work adjacent to Central Avenue (TH65)
- Anoka County
 - Work adjacent to Main Street
- Metro Transit
 - Coordination for Future F-Line (Bus Rapid Transit)









Project Bidding

- Advertised for bid on June 1, 2023
- Bid letting held on June 22, 2023
- Received four bids
- Low bid by Park Construction Company of \$1,776,297.26



Cost of Bids Received

- Park Construction Company bid total of \$1,776,297.26 is 13.4% below the final engineer's estimate of \$2,051,237.77
- 2023 CIP budget is \$1,910,000
- Cost analysis shows generally reasonable bids received.
- Assessments projected to be within estimates.

- Coordinate with Columbia Heights, MnDOT, Anoka County, and Metro Transit.




Recommendation
