## 40' Lot Development Guidelines

Per Fridley City Code, 205.31 O-6 Overlay, Pre-1955 Lots

## **Guidelines**

\*\*Lot must have been platted prior to 1955

Minimum lot size = 4,000 sq. ft.

Minimum lot width = 40 ft.

Lot Coverage = 35%, includes roofed structures only.

## Setbacks:

- Front yard = 25 ft.
- Side yard = 7.5 ft.
  - A house <u>without</u> an attached garage 7.5 ft. on one side and 13 ft. on the other side so there is room to access a detached garage in the rear yard
  - A house <u>with</u> an attached garage 5 ft. for the attached garage, provided the height of the garage isn't more than 14 ft. at the midspan.
- Corner lots
  - Setback on a street side of a corner lot is 7.5 ft for a dwelling, attached or detached garage, or a garage that opens on the side street.
  - Setback on a street side of a corner lot is 20 ft. from the back of the curb to ensure there is space to park a vehicle.
- Rear yard
  - o 25 ft. for living area
  - 15 ft. for an attached garage
  - o 3 ft. for a detached garage, if not adjacent to a street.

## Height:

- Maximum height is 30 ft.
  - o If a new house is being constructed on a lot, the height of the structure needs to be designed to blend and maintain balance with the structures of either side.
