

## Documents to be Submitted for Commercial Plan Review

All plans must be signed by a licensed architect or licensed engineer with the State of Minnesota. Any unsigned plans will be rejected. Review may <u>NOT</u> start until the proper plans and specifications have been received. We do not offer an expedite option or up-front fees at this time.

Payment will be required once the application has gone through the approval processes.

## New Construction, Additions and/or changing footprint:

- 1. Application (completed online)
- 2. One plan set (must be signed)
- 3. Watershed Permit (apply with watershed district)
- 4. SAC Determination Letter (Apply with Metropolitan Council)
- 5. Survey / Site Plan
- 6. Landscape Plan
- 7. Energy Calcs
- 8. City Contractor License
- 9. Special Inspection Schedule
- 10. Performance Bond

## Interior Alterations, Remodels and/or <u>not</u> changing footprint (no exterior work being performed):

- 1. Application (completed online)
- 2. One plan set (must be signed)
- 3. SAC Determination Letter
- 4. City Contractor License
- 5. Special Inspection Schedule

Note: Special Inspection form is only required when structural concrete, welding or other structural changes are being done.
