DESCRIPTION:

This neighborhood park was recently reconstructed with park improvements and an added stormwater storage area, due to ongoing issues with flooding within the park.

Redevelopment included grading in a stormwater storage area to protect the active recreation amenities. Additional improvements included removal of the formal ballfield and replacement with a flexible open lawn space, a new single tennis court to replace the previous double court, resurfacing of the basketball hald court, and new trails to provide a more direct connection to the adjacent Riverview Heights Park which is more focused on passive recreation providing complementary types of recreation.


RECOMMENDATIONS & ESTIMATE OF PROBABLE COSTS:

• Complete playground equipment replacements with optional picnic shelter


The estimate of probable costs for completing the recommendations range from approximately \$60,000 to \$80,000 with a high priority in order to finalize the park.
