## Approving Park System Improvement Plan Final Report and Authorizing Staff to Begin Implementation of the Plan

**Whereas,** the City of Fridley has contracted services from consultant WSB to create a Park System Improvement Plan (Plan); and

**Whereas,** Fridley residents have been engaged in the development of the Plan through surveys, events, Town Hall meetings, task force groups, and social media; and

**Whereas,** the Plan has been developed to distribute park improvements across the Fridley community to enhance and modernize Community Parks as well as neighborhood parks; and

**Whereas**, the Plan includes analysis of underserviced areas, barriers to parks and demographics in Fridley to propose park improvement priorities that better meet the needs of all residents; and

**Whereas**, the Fridley City Council received recommendations from the Park System Improvement Plan Finance and Refinement Task Force groups which have informed a plan not to exceed \$30 million dollars and a ten-year implementation; and

**Now, therefore be it resolved,** that the City Council of the City of Fridley hereby approves the Park System Improvement Plan Final Report and authorizes staff to begin the implementation phase of the Plan.
