Subject: Update to Fridley Public Safety Investigation of Threat to Fridley Public Schools

On January 14, officers arrested a person of interest, a 13-year-old male juvenile, in relation to a threat to Fridley district schools. The juvenile is being held at the Lino Lakes Juvenile Detention Facility.

As Fridley Public Safety was conducting their investigation of the initial threat, authorities were made aware of additional potential threats on various social media platforms. Detectives are currently investigating every lead received.

The investigation is ongoing in collaboration with local, state and federal authorities. No further information will be released at this time.
