

2024 Street Rehabilitation Project

Construction Update
October 25th, 2024

Substantial Completion (All Project Areas):

This week, the Contractor completed bituminous joint saw & seal operations and reinstalled pavement markings along Lucia Lane, Channel Road, 66th Avenue and Norton Avenue. The project is now substantially complete with no additional major construction activity to occur.

Over the course of the coming weeks, the Contractor will be on site intermittently to perform minor work and address items missed during initial construction. During this time, project residents are encouraged to contact staff with any outstanding construction-related items.

Construction

The Contractor's hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday-Friday. There is potential for occasional work outside of these hours upon City approval.

Please keep in mind that this type of construction may generate noise, dust, mud, and be disruptive to the area. Please be patient with the Contractor and contact us if you have any concerns we can help with.

Resident Access

The City and Contractor will work to minimize inconvenience to residents during construction. Residents can expect to have driveway access during construction except when major construction events are occurring on their street. We ask that residents, including children, remain outside the immediate work zone and exercise caution navigating the project area wherever you see workers, equipment, or warning signs.
