## 53rd Avenue Roundabout Safety Project

This week, the Contractor installed the curb & gutter for the north segment of the roundabout. **The new concrete will require 7 days of curing time.** 

Next week, the Contractor will be removing the existing curb and street pavement on the south side of 53<sup>rd</sup> Avenue near the old Medtronic location and then begin installing storm structures.

# 53rd Avenue Trail and Walk Improvements Project

This week, the Contractor removed the pavement and curb on the south side of 53<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. The Contractor also installed a new watermain on 53<sup>rd</sup> Avenue from 5<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Street.

## 53rd Avenue One Way and Detour

Beginning Monday September 11, 2023,  $53^{rd}$  Avenue from Main Street to Monroe will be a one way only for west bound traffic. East bound traffic will be detour at  $53^{rd}$  Avenue and  $4^{th}$  Street.

We understand this is an inconvenience for traveling to your home and surrounding business, but this is for the safety of the workers and will speed up the project completion date.

Please note that all construction scheduling is tentative, weather-dependent, and subject to change.

#### **Street Parking:**

As a reminder, no street parking will be allowed in this section. This provides the Contractor with room to work and prevents any damage to vehicles or personal property. Vehicles parked within the immediate work area during certain phases of construction may be subject to towing.

We thank you for your continued cooperation and patience!

#### Construction

The Contractor's hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday-Friday. There is potential for occasional work outside of these hours upon City approval.

Please keep in mind that this type of construction may generate noise, dust, mud, and be disruptive to the area. Please be patient with the Contractor and contact us if you have any concerns we can help with.

#### **Resident and Business Access**

The City and Contractor will work to minimize inconvenience to residents and businesses during construction. Residents and businesses can expect to have access during construction. We ask that residents, and businesses remain outside the immediate work zone and exercise caution when navigating the project area wherever you see workers, equipment, or warning signs.
