



# 2024 Street Rehabilitation Project

Construction Update

August 16, 2024

## **Water Main Replacement (Channel Road):**

This week, the Contractor completed replacement of the existing watermain along Channel Road north of 68<sup>th</sup> Avenue and began replacement work from Mississippi Street (CSAH 6) to 66<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

Next week, the Contractor will continue watermain replacement work along Channel Road and begin reinstatement of permanent services.

## **Temporary Water Service (Channel Road – 6670 Channel Road to ~600' North):**

In preparation for the final phase of water main replacement work along Channel Road, next week the Contractor will activate an additional above-ground temporary water system to provide water service to impacted properties along Channel Road. The temporary water service is typically run through the yard and connects to your home's outside hose spigot. Please note the temporary water system is sampled and tested per the Minnesota Department of Health's standards prior to activation.

## **Roadway Preparation and Drainage Swale Grading (Norton Avenue, Lucia Lane, and Buchanan Street):**

Next week, the Contractor will begin grading and preparation of the roadway base along Norton Avenue and mill the existing bituminous surface on Buchanan Street in preparation for upcoming paving. Following milling, Buchanan Street will have a grooved surface, but will remain open and accessible for all traffic.

The Contractor will also begin construction the Lucia Lane cul-de-sac and drainage improvements to the existing drainage swale on the north end of Lucia Lane to the MnDOT ditch.

***Please note that all construction scheduling is tentative, weather-dependent, and subject to change.***

## **Construction**

The Contractor's hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday-Friday. There is potential for occasional work outside of these hours upon City approval.

Please keep in mind that this type of construction may generate noise, dust, mud, and be disruptive to the area. Please be patient with the Contractor and contact us if you have any concerns we can help with.

## **Resident Access**

The City and Contractor will work to minimize inconvenience to residents during construction. Residents can expect to have driveway access during construction except when major construction events are occurring on their street. We ask that residents, including children, remain outside the immediate work zone and exercise caution navigating the project area wherever you see workers, equipment, or warning signs.
