To scale certificate of survey, by a licensed surveyor.			
Showing north arrow, existing and proposed structures,			
legal description, adjacent street names, and buildings on			
adjacent lots within 10 feet of the common lot lines.			
To scale site plan, showing the location of buildings, off-			
street parking, street and utility locations, auto and			
pedestrian access to and from the project.			
Plans showing any modification to existing utility services,			
grading plans and storm water plans.			
Plans showing the building exterior elevations, lighting,			
signing and landscape plan.			
Detailed narrative explaining the project compatibility			
with the overall Transit Oriented Development District.			

Plans to be submitted should include three (1) <u>FOLDED</u> full size copes, with one (1) 11x17 to-scale reduction and one (1) 8 % x 11 reduction and an electronic pdf file via e-mail or USB Flash Drive.

The City reserves the right, based on a case by case analysis, to waive any of the above requirements.

The City also reserves the right, to require additional submittal items if it is deemed necessary to act upon the master plan.
