

To get involved...

1. Fill out an Adopt-A-Park application, online or paper, at FridleyMN.gov/AdoptAPark.
2. Staff will review your application and then contact you about setting up a time to visit your adopted park for a training.
3. Complete a short training with parks staff, then sign and submit a volunteer agreement.
4. Start cleaning up your adopted park!

Who can adopt?

The Adopt-A-Park program welcomes all community members to adopt a park including residents, neighborhoods, schools, community groups, faith-based organizations, and businesses.

Each volunteer or group will have a sign dedicated to them in the park they have adopted. Show the community that you care about the health and quality of our beautiful parks!



Expectations & Commitment

- Fill out an Adopt-a-Park application.
- Make a 1-2 year commitment to clean up your adopted park.
- Clean and maintain the park at least four times a year.
- Participants under 18 years of age must have supervision of a participant who is 18 years of age or older.
- Call parks office if there are any comments or concerns.
- Volunteers will undergo a short training period before they start cleaning their park.

Responsibilities

Varies from each park.

- *Weed the playgrounds/volleyball courts/gardens.*
- *Pick trash off of trails, playgrounds, and fields.*
- *Maintain area around park signs.*
- *Report vandalism to parks and recreation staff.*
